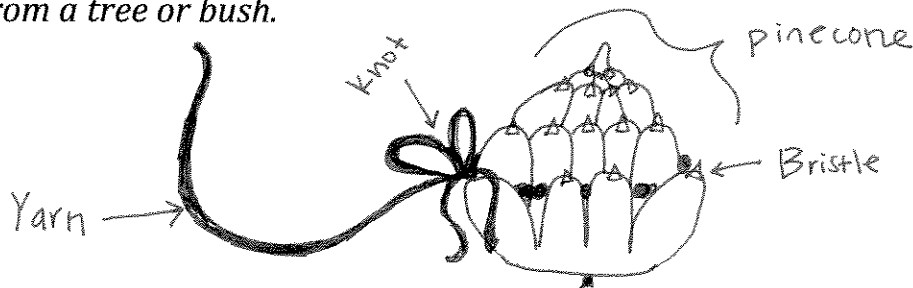
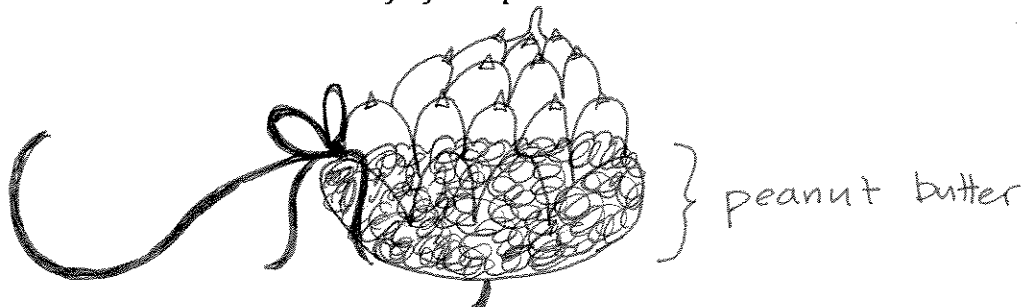


# How to Make a Bird Feeder Out of a Pinecone

- 1. Choose your pine cone.**
- 2. Take the ball of yarn, and cut a 1 foot section of yarn.**
- 3. Tie one end of your yarn to the middle of the pine cone.**  
*When tying the yarn to the cone, push the yarn between the pinecone's bristles. The yarn loose end of the yarn will be used to hang the pinecone from a tree or bush.*



- 4. Smear peanut butter on the big end of the pinecone.** *The peanut butter should cover half of the pine cone.*



- 5. Roll the pinecone in the tray of birdseed until the peanut butter is completely covered in birdseed.**
- 6. Write your name on a bag.**
- 7. Put the pinecone into your bag.**
- 8. When you get home, hang the pinecone from a tree branch or a bush.**
- 9. Wait a few days, and see if birds come to eat the seeds.** *If they do not start eating it within 3 – 4 days, sprinkle birdseed on the ground near the feeder. It may take a little while for the birds to notice it. If they still don't come, try moving the pinecone to a different place.*
